

REGULATIONS

on amendments to Regulations for the University of Akureyri no. 387/2009
with amendments no. 494/2011 and no. 1133/2011

Article 1

In sentence 2 of paragraph 1 in Article 8, the term “Academic Administration” is deleted and replaced by the term “Student Registry”.

Article 2

In sentence 1 of paragraph 1 in Article 15, the word “two” is deleted and replaced by the word “four”.

Article 3

The following amendments are made to sentence 1 of paragraph 1 in Article 21:

In item b), the term “Academic Administration” is deleted and replaced by the term “Student Registry”.

In item d), the term „Upplýsingasvið“ is deleted and replaced by the term “Library and Information Services of the University of Akureyri”.

In item e), the term “RHA - Research and Development Centre” is deleted and replaced by the term “RHA - University of Akureyri Research Centre”.

Two new items are added to the Article: f) KHA - Centre for Teaching and g) Student Counselling Services.

Article 4

The following amendments are made to Article 23:

The term “Academic Administration” is deleted and replaced by the term “Student Registry”.

In item b), the following is deleted: “Office management for the University's Schools” and replaced by “Distance teaching”.

Items d), e) and f) are deleted.

Article 5

The following amendment is made to Article 25:

The term „Upplýsingasvið“ is deleted and replaced by the term ”Library and Information Services of the University of Akureyri”.

Article 6

The following amendment is made to Article 26:

The term “RHA - Research and Development Centre” is deleted and replaced by the term “RHA - University of Akureyri Research Centre”.

Article 7

The following is added to sentence 1 of paragraph 1 in Article 24: “as well as international relations”. The sentence becomes as follows:

Marketing and Public Relations is mainly concerned with the marketing and promotion of the University as well as international relations, but is also involved in tasks to do with public relations and conferencing.

Article 8

Article 27 is added to Chapter IV. The Article becomes as follows (new Article):

KHA – Centre for Teaching

The aim and role of KHA - Centre for Teaching is to provide professional assistance to teachers in the development of teaching methods, whether it be in on-campus or distance studies. The Centre for Teaching provides general counselling according to its defined role, holds courses and attends to development work with an emphasis on information technology and pedagogy. KHA contributes to increased use of computer and information technology at the University and provides students and staff with assistance and advice in that area.

Article 9

Article 28 is added to Chapter IV. The Article becomes as follows (new Article):

Student Counselling Services

Student Counselling provides the students of the University with various services, support and instruction during their studies. In addition, Student Counselling instructs prospective students in selecting studies and provides advice and information on studies at the University and services within the University available to students and the public. The student counsellor of the University oversees matters concerning disabled students and students with specific learning difficulties.

Article 10

Instead of Article 27, Chapter V starts with Article 29. The numbering of subsequent Articles in the Regulations change accordingly.

Article 11

The following amendments are made to Article 31:

In sentence 1 of paragraph 2, the term “Academic Administration” is deleted and replaced by the term “Student Registry”.

Article 12

These regulations, approved by the University Council on 23 January 2015, are set on the basis of Act no. 85/2008, with subsequent amendments, and immediately enter into force.
